Responsibilities

- Assume ownership of day-to-day support activities and customer interactions.
- Monitor trading platforms and exchange GUIs for rejected orders and resolve as necessary (FCM side).
- Monitor the order router and client activities, including order approval (BD side).
- Monitor risk reports and take action as necessary.
- Participate in projects and process improvement initiatives.
- Interact with developers and technology to address problems as they present, as well as new features and functionalities. Ability to write specs, manage projects and ability to test highly preferred: seeing projects through to completion is an important way to contribute to the growth of the firm.
- Ensure trading and compliance processes are completed; escalate issues to management.
- Support other teams at Phillip as necessary.
